The once booming pulp and paper industry is slowing down to a dull roar. After years of production and change, the west coast mills are shutting down, one by one.

On a recent visit to Campbell River, the closure of the Catalyst owned Elk Falls Mill was very noticable. The air was free of the undeniable stench of toxins and pollution. The ocean breezes were refreshing and enjoyable.

The closure in Campbell River had a definite negative impact on the economy. The oceanside route going into town seemed like a giant garage sale, with cars, boats, motorhomes and numerous homes all for sale along the road. Behind the bargains and deals, lives were being hit hard as families are trying to navigate through the financial uncertainties.

Is this the price to pay for clean air? Is this what is going to happen to Crofton, I wondered.

The Crofton mill's website states

"The unprecedented layoffs within the salaried workforce reflect the severity of recent demand declines and the likelihood that curtailed production will not restart in the short term.

The severance of 42 employees will be completed over the next few months as the business continues to streamline its corporate structure and support functions. Staff layoffs will take effect June 8, 2009.

'This is an exceptionally difficult time in the industry and current market conditions cannot support the current staffing level,' said Richard Garneau, president and chief executive officer."

The inevitable shut down of the mill is most likely welcome news for supporters of the 2004 Clean Air Concert. With performances by Neil Young, Barenaked Ladies, Randy Bachman, and Tal Bachman, the concert raised \$50,000 for an environmental impact study of the pulp mill in Crofton.

The independent study was commissioned by the Crofton Airshed Citi-

zens Group, which claims government standards for pulp-and-paper emissions are insufficient.

Despite all the lobbying, studies and concerns, it is clear that our natural resources can no longer handle our abuse and misuse. One way or another all of us are going to have to radically change our lifestyles and endure drastic readjustments to our way of life, and our economics. It is a frightening thing to have the economic stability of our lives and our families shattered. For better or worse all of us are in the same boat, we will have to help each other see beyond these dark times.

Once the smog has settled, we may be losing jobs, but we will be saving our planet, and preserving a future for our children and grandchildren.

Through the years spicy foods have become more and more popular, as we all have become more international and have been exposed to hot and spicy foods from Asia, the Middle East and Latin countries. More and more of us are learning to love these foods. Spices are like an aphrodisiac. Our hearts beat faster, our eyes tear, our noses run and we sweat. (Enjoyably so). Spices make us feel alive, our metabolism and energy levels increase and we feel uplifted, particularly in our bland lives, or in the doldrums of winter. (Heats up the innards)

But what I find most exhilarating is that the curries and the hot dishes I prepare are also very healthy for us. Jalapeno peppers have three times more vitamin C than oranges, with antioxidants and other good things like Niacin. The active ingredient in hot chilli peppers is called capsaicin. Studies have shown that it improves circulation, relieves pain and, fights cancer. And, when the tongue burns and we feel the pain of hot, spicy peppers the body is kind of tricked into releasing "endorphins" that make us feel good and help us heal. Other spices that give us hot food like Garlic, Ginger, Curcumin and Tumeric have been known for centuries for their beneficial circulatory, systemic and infection fighting properties.

So spicy foods are not only simply invigorating and delicious, they are amazingly good for you too.

Here is one of my favourite recipes,

SPICY LENTIL SOUP

3 cups red lentils and 6 cups of water 1/4 cup vegetable oil (1tablespoon bacon fat-optional) 1 medium yellow onion finely chopped 1 medium tomato (soft) finely chopped 5 cloves of garlic minced 5 whole cloves

1 small can tomato paste

1 cinnamon stick

3 tablespoons curry powder

1/4 cup chopped cilantro

1/2 teaspoon salt

Rinse the lentils in a deep sauce pan and rinse with cold water until its clear, place on heat and boil for 5 to 7 minute. Place the oil in a pan on high, once hot add the cinnamon, cloves and onions – stir in the beginning and once again when the onions are brown (nearly black). Add the tomatoes and curry powder – keep stirring to a soft paste texture. Turn the heat down and pour the lentils into it and stir. Top with chopped cilantro. Add a little more water if required (Not to much other wise you will lose the taste of the curry) Bon appétit'

May be enjoyed with chapatti or naan also – it can be served over basmati rice complemented with papa Dum.




Get Caught in "The Labyrinth"






