Sailing: A great way to spend the day

At first I couldn't decide if it was going to be a good day for sailing or a better day for suntanning. As it turned out, the day my family and I went out with Don Mellor of L'Orenda Sailing, was a perfect day for sailing. With just enough sun to warm our faces (and burn my nose) and plenty of wind to let the mainsail and jib do most of the work, we cruised out of Ganges Harbour with a true sense of adventure. Our captain Don, actually made the sailing work look effortless, but that's only because he has over 30 years of sailing experience and has been in the local waters for at least 15 of those.

Although Don is fully certified with the Canadian Sailing Association, the Power Squadron and is an ISPA qualified sailing instructor, his seamanship is in his blood. His grandfather was a boatbuilder in the shipyards in Victoria during the war. His family on his mother's side has been boatbuilding and sailing the Pacific Northwest for many years. This tradition and skill is evident in Don's 39' Gaff-rigged yawl which he built himself 20 years ago. It is very clean and lovingly maintained. Don even keeps a bucket of water and washrag handy on deck, so he can keep the yacht immaculate as he cruises.

There were 11 guests on board, including myself, my husband, our 5 year old and the youngest sailor yet, 19 day old Tiana. Don has had guests from all over the world, all kinds of interesting people and all kinds of interesting stories to tell about some of his trips. He has had various groups including weddings, memorial services, stag parties and private corporate parties on his daytime and sunset cruises. He welcomes each new sailor with enthusiasm and kindness, as he offers life jackets, cushions, blankets, windbreakers and anything else to make his guests feel comfortable.

On our four hour cruise, we motored out of the very busy Ganges Harbour, past seals poking their curious noses above the waves, past kayakers and lasers at Chocolate Beach. Once we made it beyond the three

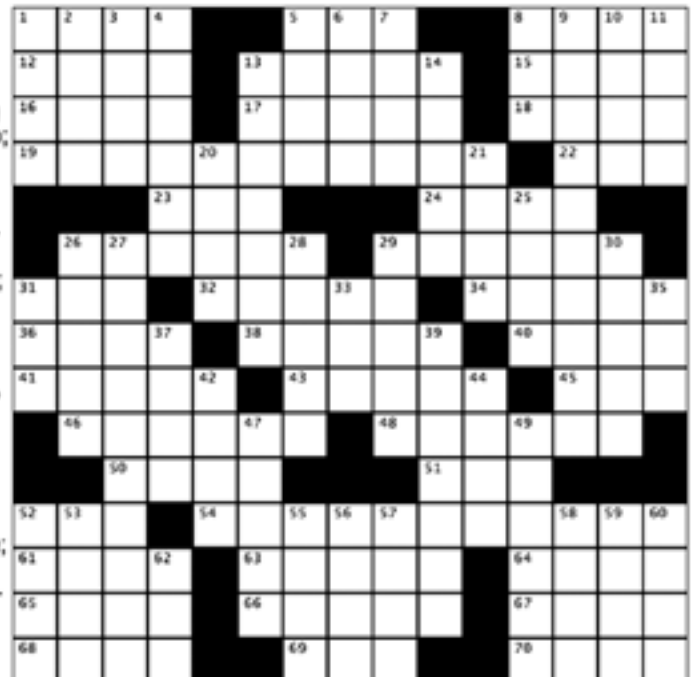

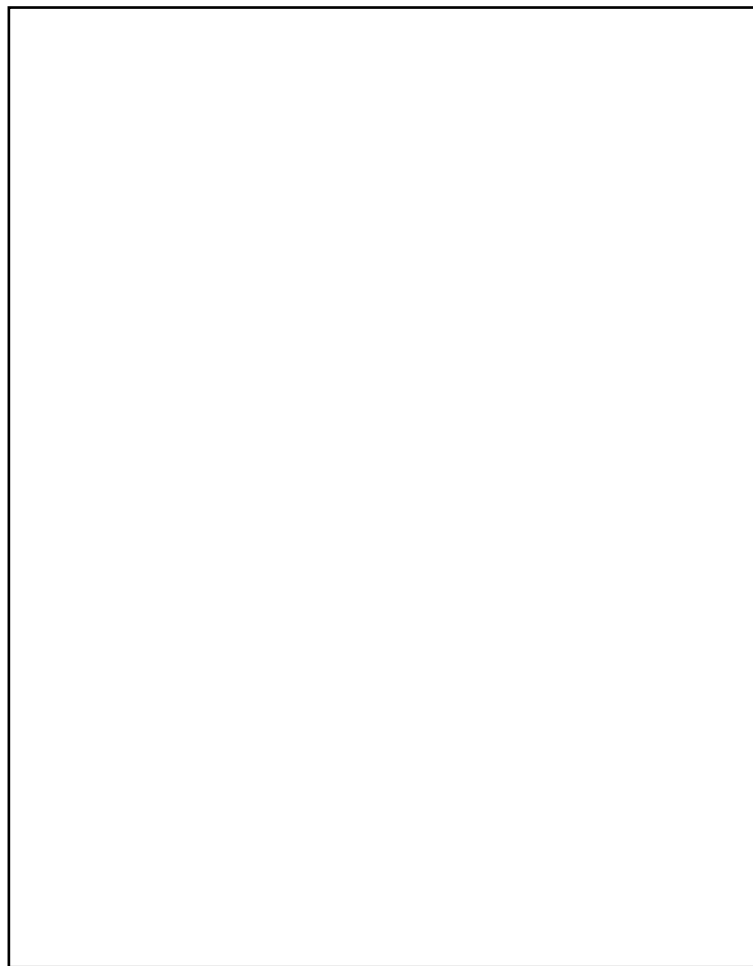

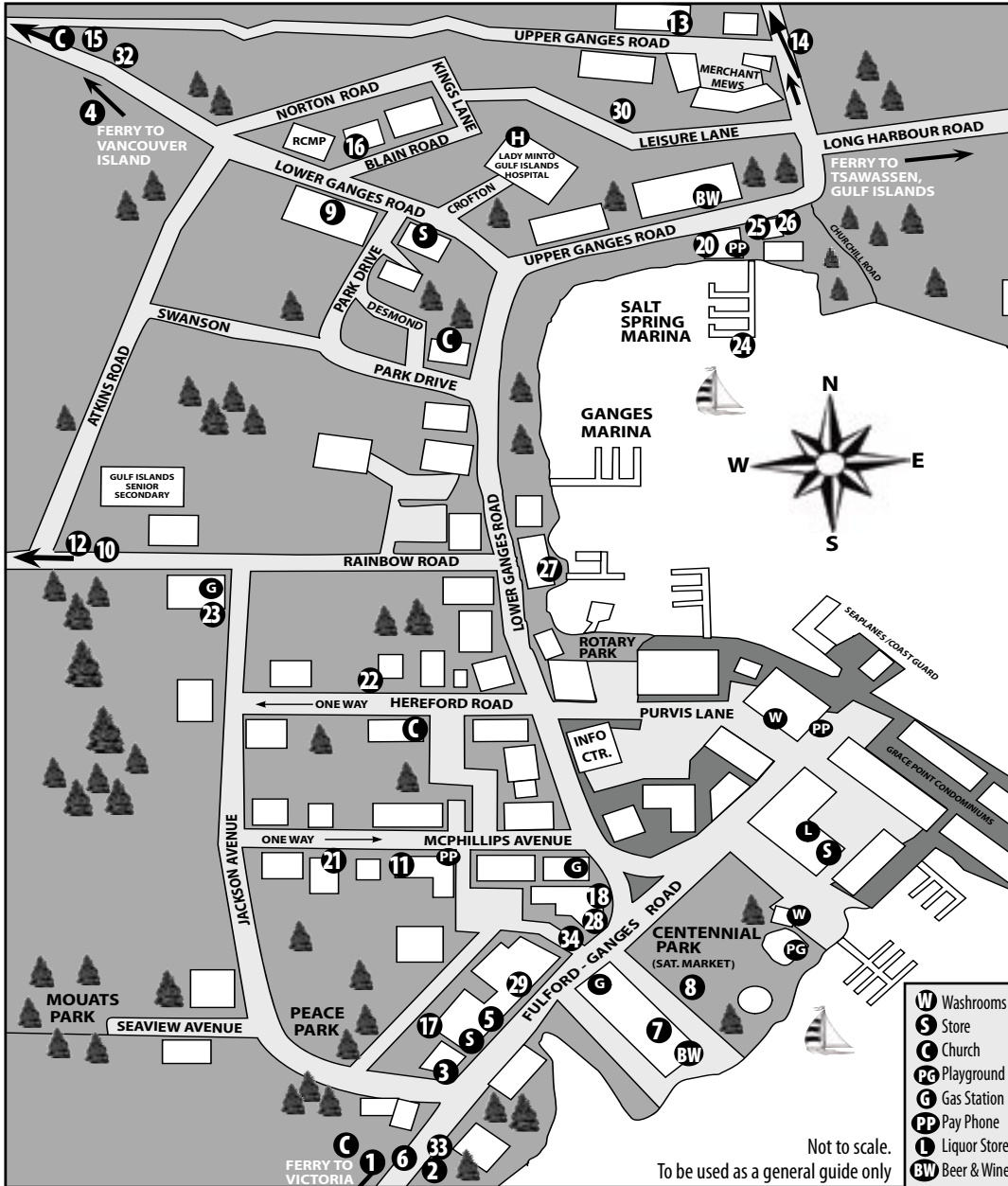
