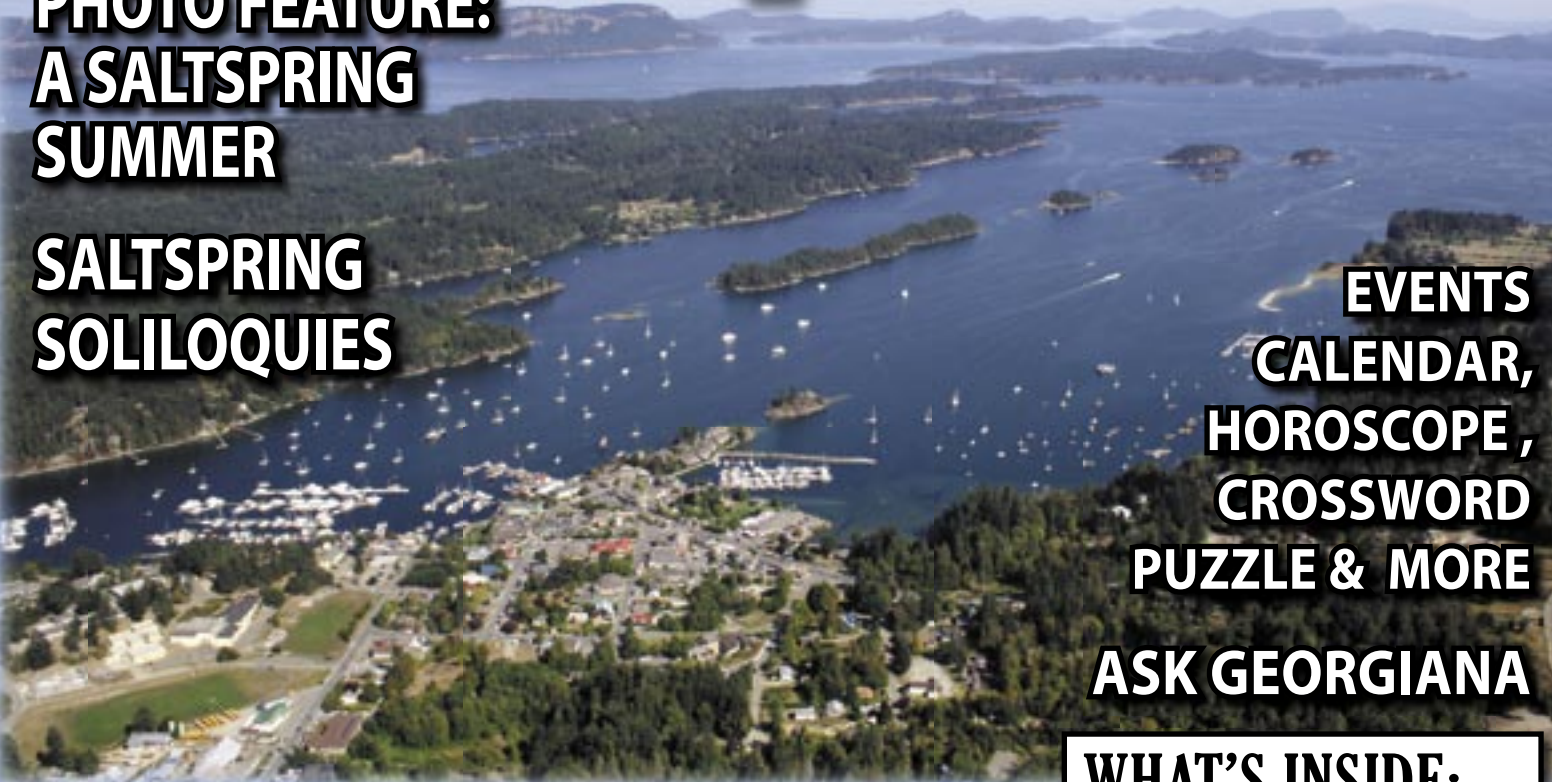

TOMATOES... TOMATOES... TOMATOES...

So I thought that in a last column about our gardens, I would like to pass on some recipes to take advantage of our bumper crop of beautiful tomatoes.

It is always such a sin to waste food, especially those fruits and vegetables we have so carefully and lovingly cultivated. Enjoy my recipes!

GRILLED FISH WITH TOMATOES

Turn on your oven grill. Your choice of fish, make sure it is washed and dabbed with paper towel to remove excessive water. Lightly dust with seasoned flour on both sides. Get a grilling pan and lightly butter the pan. Place the fish in the pan and lightly butter the top side of the fish. Cut the tomatoes in half (one per serving) and place around the in the pan, lightly salt and pepper. Place in the grill for 5-7 minute until light golden brown. Bon Appétit!

STUFFED TOMATOES WITH SCRAMBLED EGGS AND CHEESE

Hollow out a large tomato. Stuff it with fresh scrambled eggs and top with a mixture of cheddar and mozzarella cheese. Sprinkle with salt and pepper place under the broiler until the cheese has melted.

Add parsley, basil or dill or your choice of herbs. Makes a delicious breakfast treat or a side entre.'

TOMATO ZUCCHINI PARMESAN

Slice 2 onions, 3 zucchinis and 7 tomatoes (and 1 eggplant-optional) and place them in a pot. Add basil, oregano and salt and pepper to taste. Add a touch of Worcestershire sauce and tobacco. Let it simmer for 5-7 minutes and place in a serving dish. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese and bake for 20 minutes.

Fabulous - served on the side with steak, lasagna or on its own. Enjoy!

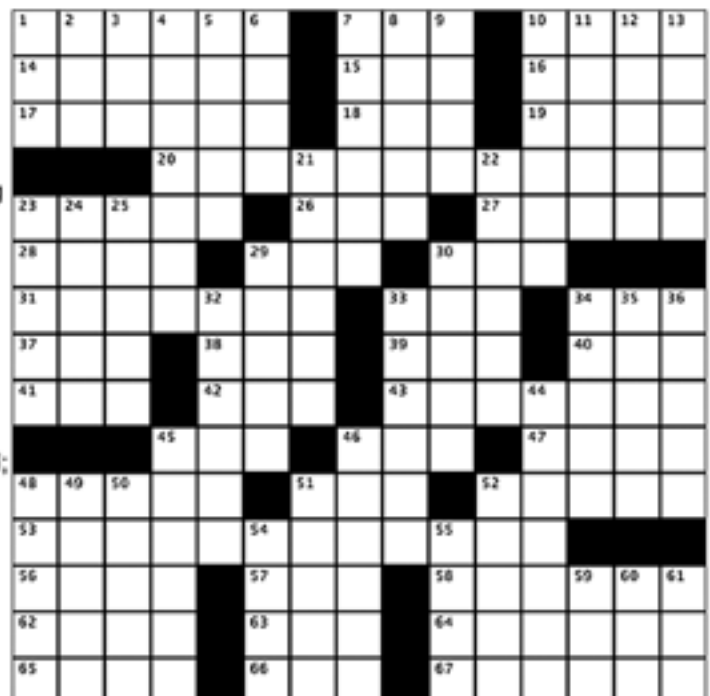
