30 Years of Cinema at Central Hall

On October 13th, 1978 Woody Allen's film *Annie Hall* became the first film ever to light up the silver screen at Central Hall and thus began a tradition that has lasted 30 years! Two 16mm projectors, balanced on a platform surrounded by blankets to cut down on the noise, were used to screen the films from then on, along with a painted plywood "screen" for the image and guitar amps for the sound. It all got the job done and gave the island a cinema after The Rex in Ganges had closed in the early 1960's. The original Island Cinema was a repertory cinema, playing older films exclusively which, before the days of the VCR or DVD, islanders were excited to see week after week.

After 30 years of showing movies to Salt Springers at Central Hall, the cinema has graduated to industry standard 35mm projection, a full-size screen, Dolby surround sound and first-run features year-round. Organic popcorn, spritzers & chocolates are featured along with the usual goodies you'd find in any "regular" cinema. Films continue to be diverse despite being contemporary features. This follows on the traditions set by the Nye sisters who owned the cinema (Salt Spring Cinema) throughout much of the '90s; they initiated

the Great Canadian Film Festival and were great at promoting the out of the ordinary films that weren't getting the attention that the big Hollywood films were garnering thanks to massive domestic advertising.

On Sunday Nov. 30th from 3:00 - 5:00 we hope to see cinema goes past & present, former & current employees and any other islanders who'd love to reminisce about the "old" days with the former owners of the cinema...yes, Danny will be coming along as well as Louise! 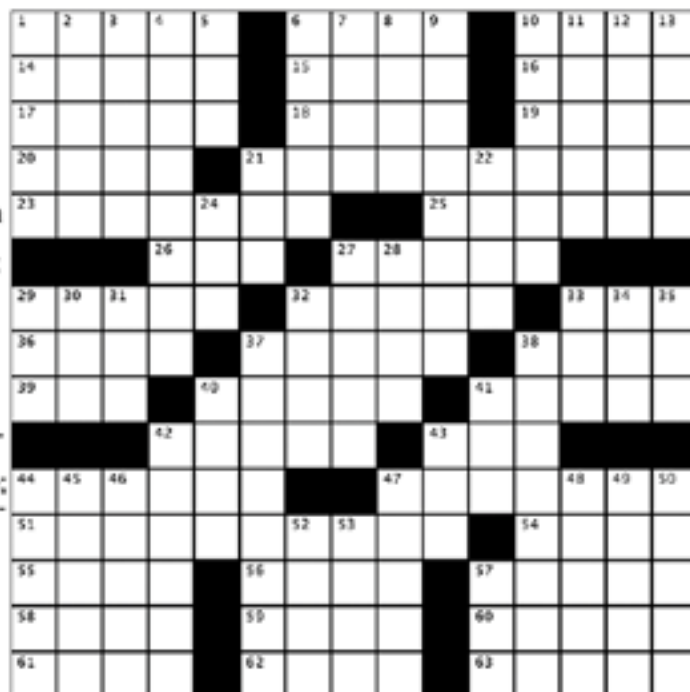

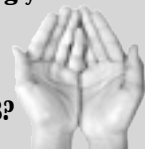

Here are some tips you may find helpful:

HOUSEHOLD TIPS:

COOKING TIP

5. Heat, but do not boil.

6. Serve hot makes 10-15 delicious glasses.
