



Local palliative caregiver/teacher featured in weekend film festival documentary "Griefwalker"

im Wilson's film, *Griefwalker*, a new National Film Board production is coming to Salt Spring Island on March 8th, 2009 at the Our Island, Our World 10th Annual Film Festival at Gulf Islands Secondary School - room 210, on Salt Spring Island with Q&A by Stephen Jenkinson.

First shown at Montreal's 2008 World Film Festival, *Griefwalker* is the National Film Board of Canada's documentary on the life and work of visionary Canadian palliative care teacher and island resident, Stephen Jenkinson.

Griefwalker is Tim Wilson's extraordinary portrait of Stephen Jenkinson's work with the dying. Whether sitting at the bedside of a dying woman, or speaking to clinicians whose job it is to delay death as long as possible, Jenkinson bears a message that most people do not want to hear: that our deaths are not something to be denied or avoided, but "befriended."

The film is framed by Wilson's wrestling with his denial of his own death as he nearly succumbs to a sudden illness, and his having to face the death of someone very close to him. *Griefwalker* weaves an illuminating picture of a remarkable man, and leaves us with a deeper understanding of how our deaths should be held as "a prized possession."



Geoff Berner ~ The Avenging Angel of klezmer

Geoff Berner released his first solo EP Light Enough To Travel in 2000. The title song was also covered by The Be Good Tanya's the same year and became a hit for them. Between then and now Berner has focused his attention on learning more about his Eastern European Jewish roots and especially the music that came from the region, klezmer.

His latest album, "Klemzer Mongrels" released this winter is the ultimate expression of his aggressive kind of klezmer. It's a klezmer punk folk dance album about mixed-breeds of all kinds. This is the third album of his "Whiskey Rabbi" trilogy, all recorded with the rough sound of blaring accordion, the virtuosic, scraping fiddle of Diona Davies, and the thumping, insistent rhythm of Wayne Adams' percussion. Berner says, "'Whiskey Rabbi' was mainly about booze, 'Wedding Dance of the Widow Bride' was mostly about women, and 'Klezmer Mongrels' is about the natural consequences of combining the two."

Berner wields his accordion like any of those old 50's era rock stars wielded their guitars. Let's be honest - the accordion is the last instrument of the true rebel starting way back in the old world through to today you have to be a little bit daring to play an accordion. Berner carries this daring through

pretty much everything he does from the artwork of the Klezmer Mongrels album to his Official Theme Song for the 2010 Vancouver / Whistler Olympic Games.

Berner's Olympic theme song with lyrics that chastise the use of public money to hold a big party while eliminating the office that investigates the deaths of children in BC showcase his politics and upholds his beliefs of original klezmer music. Berner says, "I want to make original klezmer music that's drunk, dirty, political and passionate. Today there's a cultural battle going on between the boring forces of purity, fundamentalism and monoculture, and the fun forces of mixed-up, messed-up diversity." Klezmer Mongrels is a release that pushes for mixed-up fun. The music and lyrics are a raw assault on purity that will make listeners, laugh, bang their heads, cry, and feel absurd, all at the same time.

Having just completed a successful tour of eastern Canada, Berner and his band will be playing on Salt Spring on March 26 at Mahon Hall. Local musician Ora Cogan will be opening for him with the doors opening at 8pm and the show stating at 9pm. Advance tickets are available at Acoustic Planet and Stuff & Nonsense.
