





In exterior work, consider building with fir instead of pressure treated lumber, especially here on Saltspring. If you can maintain 18" from grade with concrete piers, sonotubes or curbs you do not have to use pressure treated lumber. With changes in materials and building regulations, stainless steel hangers, brackets and fasteners are now required when using pressure treated lumber. Costs for stainless steel instead of galvanized are prohibitive. There are a few more tips I would like to add. The most cost effective expenses in building are in the concrete foundation and insulation. Scrimping with either one of these items is not wise. And as far as building in the Pacific Northwest, if you are going to splurge, splurge on windows, skylights and solariums and atriums that bring the outdoors and natural light inside. Along with an all weather patio area, these things over time will bring you the most satisfaction and joy in your home.

Working with customers to create living space that is a joy and a delight through the years is one of the special things I have enjoyed in all my years in the construction field. Best of luck and success in bringing your particular dream into reality.




