





Digging for Treasure

So, it's Spring Cleaning time! But it's hard to know where to start. Many people are intimidated by the prospect of sorting through piles of junk in garages and basements. Who knows what we might find lurking in the corners of closets? The chaos of unorganized files, unfinished projects and outdated clothing can be overwhelming. How to decide what to save, and what to throw away?

The first step is to get organized. Start by assembling some boxes and a pile of sticky notes, pick one area of your home, and begin categorizing.

Organizing doesn't necessarily mean you have to get rid of everything. We all have resistance to letting go of our stuff. Sorting through years of memories can be a very emotional process.

But lately I've been trying a different approach. I like to think of it as a Treasure Hunt – to re-discover the hidden treasures amidst the debris of the past!

My Mom has always stubbornly refused to throw anything out. It has become like a Mantra that she repeats over and over. She saves everything, even old toilet paper rolls for craft projects. By the time she moved out of her house to an assisted living facility, her home office was stuffed floor to ceiling with yellowed newspaper clippings, and boxes full of files. Community projects mingled cheerfully with old grocery bills and party invitations. We were worried because the mice were moving in.

But she was suspicious of anyone who offered to help. My brothers threatened to bring in a dumpster. Finally I said to her, 'Mom, you have a choice: it's either lighting a match 10 years from now, or allowing me to go in and organize, so that what is important will be saved.' She finally agreed, and has decided to trust me.





Great advice to make life a little easier...

HOUSEHOLD ADVICE FROM GEORGIANA...

It is the season for gardens again, and I wanted to pass on some experiences and lessons I have learned the hard way. I love plants and have always wanted to garden. Last year we cut out a large plot in the yard and worked to make raised garden beds with soil and fertilizer. By the time we were ready to plant it was in June and I purchased bedding vegetable plants and carefully planted them in the beds. We had peas, beans, cucumbers, zucchini, tomatoes, red, green and hot peppers. But by the time everything was beginning to yield vegetables, the sunshine waned and the days and nights were too cool.

So, this year I decided to try growing plants inside and early with grow lights. And, they came up and grew luscious and green and I just couldn't wait to set them outside. This is where the lesson part comes in. I learned this: DO NOT PUT THOSE POOR BABY PLANTS OUTSIDE RIGHT AWAY!

I did. I didn't know that you have to "harden" them first. Two days after I planted those beautiful green plants they didn't look so good. Then we got some hot, sunny days, and I was thinking, "Great! Man those baby plants will surely take off now!"

"Wrona!"

For some reason changing the light from artificial to natural, and changing the environment from warm, safe inside to natural outside climate is too harsh and difficult for plants. What you are supposed to do is take them out for a few hours, then bring them in to the safe warm artificial light and warmth. And then gradually increase the time outside until they are ready to stand the new environment.

This is the way you are supposed to do it. Lots of people know this, apparently. Not me.

Some poor baby plants had to die to learn this lesson. Maybe you can avoid this sacrifice with these words of sad advice. As always there is book learning, and there is practical knowledge. I hope these practical words of advice will help you in your gardening efforts. Some lessons we learn the hard way. Hope your gardening efforts yield lovely vegetables and flowers for you this year.
