

It has been a great and sunny spring, and now we are close to the first big holiday of the summer...Canada Day. I thought it might be nice to give you some favourite dishes and treats to make that party or special occasion a fun time. ~ Sincerely, Georgiana

SPICY HERBED HAMBURGERS

Mix 2 1/2 lbs lean hamburger with finely chopped onions, garlic, ginger and cilantro (jalapeno) optional. Add ground pepper and salt to taste. Mould into patties just like making hamburgers and throw them on the grill. You can even make long patties, served in a hoagie bun topped with your choice of condiments - You are in for a real treat!

OYSTER ROCKEFELLER

This exotic treat is really quite easy to prepare.

Shuck a dozen of your favourite oysters and place them in a metal pan ready for the grill. In a saucepan on medium high - melt a tablespoon of butter and sauté half a medium onion finely chopped. Add two teaspoons of red pimentos, two teaspoons of bacon bits and a small bag of baby spinach (5 to 7 cups). Add a 1/4 cup of sweet to medium red wine, and a couple of pinches of salt and pepper and stir. Put a lid on it and turn the heat down for 2 minutes. Place the mixture on top of oysters in the shell covering them. Finally, place fresh grated parmesan cheese on each oyster grill them to golden brown. If you have never tried oysters, you will love these!

TRADITIONAL SPANISH SANGRIA

There are many favourite recipes for this party drink, and here is another one. Start with 1 bottle of your favourite red wine. (Personally I prefer a Shiraz). Then I add 1/4 cup of cognac. (You can also use gin, or triple sec.) Cut 2 lemons and 2 oranges into thin slices, and 1 lime into wedges. 2 tablespoons of sugar and 4 cups of the carbonated beverage of your choice...like ginger ale. Add a cup of orange juice or lemonade and it is ready. Another tasty addition to this recipe is to add fresh pineapple and grapes... strawberries and raspberries are optional I have also tried adding orange curacao for a lovely difference.

Try your own concoction and you will see why there are so many ways of preparing this delightful party drink. Mix everything together and stir well. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours and you are well stocked for your summer party with all your friends, pour over ice.

years ago when like the ragtag survivors of Battlestar Galactica I found refuge in this magnificent country, Canada, I have often wondered how on earth it has survived. Years ago there was a discussion across our nation on the question: "What is a Canadian?" I can remember a friend's comment so clearly. He said that, "Decades from now they will be having this same type of a discussion, only the question then will be, 'What was a Canadian'?"

I am not so sure. I remember the campaign slogan of Pierre Trudeau in the 1970's. "The land is strong."

Not quite right, but beneath this inane doublespeak there is a much deeper truth. It is instead the heart and soul of the people in this country that is strong. That eternal strength is buried deep and you do not often see it, but it is there. It is the kind of raw, dormant power that when finally stirred into motion changes history, like the fall of the Berlin Wall. And it leaves the broken chains and constraints of government, tradition and power in its wake.

There are just a few moments where I caught a glimpse of that raw and secret power hidden in the heart and soul of Canadians. On a cold, wintry day in Russia at Luznicki Stadium in 1972, Paul Henderson captured our nation in one priceless, unforgettable moment with an unbelievable and impossible goal. I can still remember standing there together with an entire country in pure, wild and spontaneous joy.

And when the image of that young, valiant Terry Fox, with his hobbling, hop-glide-step all alone across the wide expanse of Quebec and Eastern Canada finally came into our living rooms it spoke one and all straight to the heart of every

So, I know now how the bumblebee can fly. It has become an instinctive, visceral knowledge that obeys no laws of nature, or reason. Beyond the threshold of another century, Canada will somehow survive. And until that secret strength hidden in the heart and soul of every Canadian finally blossoms the only evidence that it even exists at all will be in our Canadian humour.

From the "Schmenge" brothers and the unforgettable charisma and humanism of John Candy and Second City, to Gordon Pinsent, Michael J. Fox, Red Green, Cathy Jones and the preposterous humour of "This hour has 22 Minutes" and "The Canadian Air Farce" and so many, many more...

Canadians have given healthy, pure, irreverent and joyeous laughter to the world. This sense of comedy and laughter so endemic to the Canadian psyche comes from the goodness, hope and unconquerable quintessence mirroring the determination, grit and never-say-die spirit of what is best in us all.

All of us remember the bleak, harrowing days leading up to the final results of the last Quebec referendum. Our entire nation was stricken with shock, poised on the unthinkable precipice that our country- Canada- would be destroyed. I can remember that night. I can remember the stark horror of looking into the absolute uncertainty and chaos that was staring every single citizen of our country right in the face. I can remember the fear, the frustration, the outrage, and the despair. I turned on the television. And there was Don Ferguson strutting around in his uniform and riding crop, and John Morgan in fatigues as "Dorothy" dutifully stuffing all manner of rubbish and "separated eggs" into the "Chicken Cannon." I can still picture in my mind them standing there with Air Farce's answer to a distraught nation facing the terror of dissolution and Don Ferguson yelling "FIRE!"...and watching a picture of Lucien Bouchard be totally plastered with mangled and disgorged slop.

And I laughed. And I laughed. And I laughed.

What a country.




