Two years ago, the SSI Weavers and Spinners' Guild invited the SSI Painters' Guild to collaborate and produce a show of woven pieces inspired by a painting. The result was about 50 participants partnering and creating a spectacularly colourful and exciting exhibition called "An Eye For Colour".

The seed for this show originated from Bernat Klein's book Eye For Colour. Bernat Klein is a legendary textile designer who shook up the staid tweed industry and went on to be celebrated by French couturiers. Inspired by his own dynamic, paint-smeared abstract paintings and those of other painters, he designed and created from his own mill innovative multi-coloured and highly textured yarns. These scrumptious yarns were then woven into rich, textural cloth for the fashion industry. It is the relationship of his paintings and these textiles that is captured in Eye For Colour

Once again this fall, "An Eye For Colour" will be presented at ArtSpring when participants will have paired up to collaborate on new works of woven and painted pieces. The creative members of the two guilds come together to celebrate Bernat Klein's painterly approach and in their own way draw inspiration from each other. Some will meet regularly to follow the process of painting and weaving, sharing the creation of both. Others will begin with a finished painting or textile and be inspired to create a companion piece. Whichever approach is chosen, the result is bound to be stunning.

Recalling all the positive comments from 2006, the 2008 show promises to be a 'must see' event. "An Eye For Colour" takes place at ArtSpring October 18 to 26th. The opening is 3 to 5 pm on October 18th. Everyone welcome.







Borax: cleans wallpaper, painted walls, and floors. It deodorizes, removes stains and boosts the cleaning power of your detergents.


