

# First Defence: The Military History of Fort Rodd Hill and the Fisgard Lighthouse

### 1860 - First West Coast Lighthouse

Built 16 November, 1860, the Fisgard Lighthouse is Canada's first lighthouse on the west coast. This distinctive red brick building with the white tower is located at the entrance to Esquimalt Harbour.

# 1878 – First Coastal Artillery Batteries

The first coastal artillery batteries were created at Fort Rodd Hill in 1878 as a defensive strategy to protect the harbours of Victoria and Esquimalt. It was feared that the increasing British-Russian tensions would lead to a war and a coastal attack. Although the batteries never had to be used for any military retaliation, they were crucial in protecting the city of Victoria. The Navy ships were able to anchor securely there as well.

# 1895 – 1897 – Batteries with Disappearing Guns

The Upper Battery and Lower Battery of Fort Rodd Hill were built between 1895 and 1897 at the height of the British Empire. The "disappearing gun" system was used with one gun in the Upper Battery and two guns in the Lower Battery. Although rather slow-firing, these types of guns were hidden behind concrete, lifted to fire and then lowered to avoid being destroyed by enemy shells.

# 1898 – 1900 – The Battery with the Fast Gun

Belmont Battery, the third of Fort Rodd Hill's three batteries, was built between 1898 and 1900. The defensive strategy this time was to install fast-firing guns that could handle the quick Russian torpedo boats.

# 1905 – The Break Up of the British Pacific Squadron

The British Pacific Squadron was disbanded in 1905. The Royal Engineers and the Royal Garrison Artillery had over 60 members that stayed on at Fort Rodd Hill with Canadian Forces.

# 1916 – Almost Sinking the Wrong Submarines

According to the Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Esquimalt Military Museum, on the first day of World War I, a Fort Rodd Hill battery had the guns ready to fire at two submarines. Luckily, the fire was stopped in time as the vessels had been purchased by the BC government for the Royal Canadian Navy. It seems no one was told to expect the new subs.

### 1929 – Fisgard Lighthouse Becomes Automated

The end of lighthouse keepers in the Fisgard Lighthouse was marked by automated operation of the facilities in 1929. George Nickolas Davies had been the first full time lighthouse keeper at Fisgard. A native of Wales, he and his wife and three children took 196 days to travel to British Columbia.

### 1956 – Guns Removed From Fort Rodd Hill

The guns were removed from Fort Rodd Hill in 1956 because the equipment was considered outdated. The once strategic defence systems were replaced by new technologies. The Fort Rodd Hill National Historic Site was designated by Parks Canada in 1958 and the Site was created in 1962.

The Fisgard Lighthouse is a lasting landmark for the Royal Canadian Navy as well as a National Historic Site. The area offers a scenic viewpoint for seeing ships of all sizes sail the Strait of Juan de Fuca. The Fort Rodd Hill National Historic Site is also known for its wonderful west coast views and wildlife species such as the bald eagle, blue heron and black-tailed deer.





# Ask Georgiana

In each issue Georgiana will answer your household questions on Cooking & Cleaning



## Q: What do I do with my bumper crop of tomatoes? How about all my green tomatoes?

A: Roasted tomatoes are delicious; as they cook they dehydrate and get kind of chewy and are intensely tomato flavored. Roast them slowly at a low oven temperature. They develop a sharp and sweet flavor, and come out almost caramelized. They are good with fish, meat, vegetables, and is smashing as a topping for pizza or pasta.

Freezing tomatoes is also a good idea. They can last up to six months. They will be mushy when thawed; they too can be incorporated into meat, fish and vegetable dishes

And not to mention sauces and pasta dishes.

Green tomatoes are wonderful fried or steamed. You can make green tomato mincemeat or relish, and even green tomato cake or jelly. You can substitute green tomatoes for red ones in Salsa recipes too.

### **HOUSEHOLD TIPS:**

### **CHOPPING BOARDS**

Does your chopping board disgust you? Is it stained and ugly? Take 1/4 cup of bleach into a dishpan half full of hot water and a little dishwashing liquid and place the chopping board in the bath or in the kitchen sink and scrub. (Watch those pretty delicate fingers, use rubber gloves.) Be sure to rinse several times with really hot water. Stand to dry, or wipe with a paper towel to absorb water. Then stand or lay flat. It is also a good idea to avoid cross contamination between meat/poultry and fish cutting.




