In this issue we share stories of Christmas Around the World...

When I was 11 years old I was fortunate enough to experience a Christmas in Sweden.

Although I was young, I do remember much of our family trip. In every home we entered we were showered with gifts and food and kindness was everywhere. They were excited to have "real" Canadians in their presence. They asked if we lived in igloos and how we dealt with the polar bears!!

Although we couldn't speak swedish, my older brother and I did manage to befriend two other children. Advent Candles were lit in every window, as a welcoming to St. Lucia. Christmas Eve was the big ceremony, everyone ate and drank and exchanged gifts till late.

We sampled boysenberries, gooseberries, lutfishk, caviar and

various cheeses and crispbreads.

When we shopped in Stockholm we walked along brick and cobblestone streets, past ancient architecture along the seawall. I remember wondering if "Abba" might be practising their music in one of the old brick buildings we passed by.

When it snowed, the locals pushed sleds along the sidewalks, loaded high with their groceries and gifts.

We crossed a bridge in the bay to visit the Stockholm Zoo which is on an island, but first made the error of taking the wrong bridge to the Naval Base. The guards who greeted us on the bridge did not possess the same friendly spirit that we grew accustomed to.

My fondest memories of Christmas in Sweden was the lights, the snow and the joyful spirit of those who welcomed us. It was definitely one of my favourite Christmases ever.





Christmas Around the World

ere on Saltspring we have people from many parts of the world. I myself have spent time in many different countries. So I thought it might be interesting to tell you a little about Christmas traditions and Christmas foods from a few of the different places I have been.

CHRISTMAS IN AFRICA: Christmas is a time for celebration in Africa. In African society spirituality is an important part of life, and things are always much simpler. Presents and gifts are always simple and are centered around the family. I can remember in Uganda our presents usually consisted of a new dress or set of clothes that my mother secretly made for us during the year and she would present us with it on Christmas. The food for celebration is usually goat. Among the Kikuyu and Masai tribes in Africa certain parts of the goat are for girls, while others are for boys. Poorer families will have chicken at Christmas with chapattis, ugali (cornmeal starch), sukuma wiki(greens simmered with tomatoes) and rice. Life is always harsh and difficult there, but people come together and celebrate in their own way there just like everywhere else.

CHRISTMAS IN MALTA: Most people in Malta are Catholics and go to a midnight Mass service. The churches are decorated with colorful lights and nativity cribs ("presephju") hand made by the church goers. The figure of the baby Jesus is put on the main altar at midnight on Christmas night. "Friends of the Crib" are a group that keep the Maltese crib tradition alive. It is also a tradition for the Maltese house-wife to keep the fattest rooster especially for Christmas Lunch, which is roasted at the local bakery in a casserole full of potatoes and vegetables. The favorite desert served at Christmas is the Treacle Ring with a hot chestnut and cocoa. Nowadays the Christmas menu is more like here in North America with Christmas Turkey, Christmas Cakes, Christmas puddings and Mince pies. Sweet Chestnut soup is also very popular at Christmas.

Wash the chestnuts thoroughly and place them into a pan full of water. Leave them to soak for about 10 hours.


Boil the chestnuts using the same water. Add the rest of the ingredients and leave to simmer until the chestnuts are tender. Tip: Serve very hot.

More Christmas Around the World

CHRISTMAS IN YEMEN: Although Yemen is mostly a muslim country, there are many Christians residing there also. So Christmas is an officially declared holiday and most Yemeni people understand the meaning and traditions of Christmas. The festival of Christmas begins on the previous day and is celebrated as the Christmas Eve. ON Christmas Day the native people organize and light bonfires, lit in the front of the churchyard. The figure of the Baby Jesus is displayed for the service at the bonfire. Later the Bishop consecrates the people with a torch, which is known as the "torch of peace."

The Christmas meal is similar to everyday food, with the food served on a large platter which is shared commonly, with a hill of rice in the middle, together with Chicken, Lamb or mixed kinds of meats and many spiced veggies. The salad that accompanies the main course is also brought on one single plate, and everything is eaten commonly. Yemenis love spice and use them often. Here is a recipe for a traditional Yemeni spice rub which is called "hawayil" and is added to many dishes on special occasions, like Christmas.

Yemeni Spice Rub

SERVING SUGGESTIONS:

Add with the onions and celery. INGREDIENTS

1/3 cup caraway seeds (generous 1 ounce)

- 1/3 cup cumin seeds (about 1 ounce)
- 3 tbsp cardamom seeds (about 1/2 ounce)
- 1 tablespoon whole black peppercorns
- 4 whole cloves
- 3 tablespoons coarse kosher salt
- 3 tablespoons ground turmeric

No matter where you are in the world, Christmas is a time for celebration and people and families coming together in so many different traditions and customs.


